



The Arctic is a center of international interests, strategically significant in the context of logistics, natural resources and scientific research; a territory of unique tourist potential. On behalf of the President of the Russian Federation the Russian Government is elaborating a strategy for the development of the Russian Arctic until 2035, which provides a meaningful international agenda for the development of the region taking into consideration the specific economic and social situation of the Arctic zone of the Russian Federation.

An actively developing cooperation in the framework of the Barents Euro-Arctic region is important for the Russian Federation Arctic zone communicating Russian foreign policy in the North of Europe and in the global Arctic. In today's uneasy geopolitical landscape the Barents cooperation importance where the Russian Federation plays a key role and the Murmansk region is a leading region is on the rise.

Can the Arctic become a territory of international cooperation where European and Asian partners are ready to invest in? How to stimulate development of the interregional and international relations to create a new industrial and economic platform in the Arctic? How to keep mutual understanding in the multifaceted Arctic?


